Great progress has been made in relation to participation in FP7 from IST-Africa partner countries over the past number of years: Botswana (8 projects), Burundi (2 projects), Cameroon (22 projects), Egypt (81 projects), Ethiopia (19 projects), Ghana (42 projects), Kenya (58 projects), Lesotho (3 projects), Malawi (18 projects), Mauritius (5 projects), Mozambique (19 projects), Namibia (8 projects), Senegal (36 projects), South Africa (161 projects), Swaziland (2 projects), Tanzania (35 projects), Tunisia (67 projects) and Uganda (39 projects).
